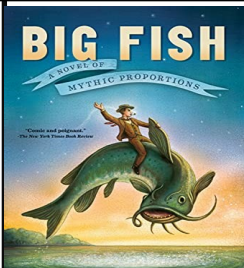


◆ Almost Maine -May 18-28 :

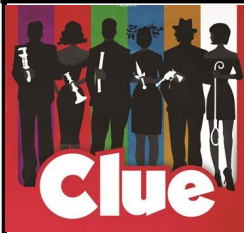

Even on his deathbed, Edward recounts fantastical anecdotes. When William, who is a journalist, starts to investigate his father's tales, he begins to understand the man and his penchant for storytelling.

Did You Know?

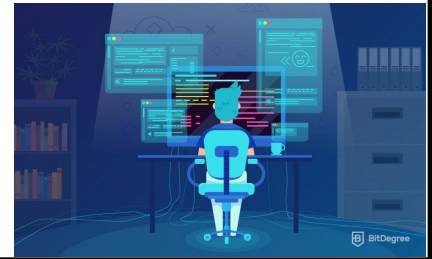
Did you know... The Haylofters is a 501C3 Not For Profit organization? Donations are tax deductible!
